Horse Management Clinic

What is it? A clinic for D members taught by older and upper level members that focuses on horse management skills tested at the D1 – D3 certifications.

Who can attend? Any member of RMR Pony Club and perspective members can attend the Horse Management clinic.

Who teaches? Each older or upper level member teaches a different horse management topic. There are 8 to 10 stations where the D members rotate through.

Cost? The clinics are free to perspective and current members.

Why hold Horse Management clinic? The clinic is a great educational experience for both the older, upper level members and D members. The clinic allows the older and upper level members to gain teaching experience and give back to their region. The D members are taught material they will need to know for their certification by their mentors.

Tips for hosting an unmounted clinic:

- Hold the HM clinic in spring right before summer certifications begin!
- The clinic should be put on annually and close to the same time each year, so members know to keep an eye out for the date!
- Have date and location picked out by the fall Regional Meeting so Board members along with DCs can plan accordingly.
- Delegate duties at the fall Regional Meeting so all board members and DCs know who to contact for questions and registration.
- Get registration and flyer sent out early so parents can plan!
