

# USPC SCHOLARSHIPS

Please review criteria for each scholarship before making application.  
If your application does not meet the scholarship criteria, it will not be considered.

**Farnam Equine Pharmaceuticals** *To reward Pony Club members for excellence in academic pursuits, and outstanding achievements in Pony Club, who have achieved a Pony Club rating of C-3 or higher and has at least a 2.0 average in their academics.*

**Vita Flex Scholarship** *To reward Pony Club members for excellence in academic pursuits, and outstanding achievements in Pony Club, who have achieved a Pony Club rating of C-3 or higher and has at least a 2.0 average in their academics.*

**Jubilee Scholarships** *To reward Pony Club members for excellence in academic pursuits, and outstanding achievements in Pony Club who have either achieved a Pony Club rating of B or higher and has at least a 2.0 average in their academics OR achieved a C-2 or higher rating and at least 3.5 GPA in their academics.*

**Renfro Scholarship** *To reward in Pony Club members the qualities that Dorothy Renfro valued most: leadership, horse management, and volunteering time, energy to beneficial activities, and to encourage Pony Club members in their academic pursuits, and who has overall average GPA of at least C.*

**Helbert Scholarship** *To encourage Pony Club members in their academic pursuits in the Liberal Arts area such as literature, music, theater, visual arts, who have an overall average GPA of at least 2.0.*

**Taylor Scholarship** *To encourage Pony Club members in their academic pursuits, and reward them for their outstanding achievements in Pony Club, commitment to and efforts on behalf of land conservation and who have achieved a C-2 or higher rating and at least 3.0 GPA in their academics.*

## Procedures

- Check the scholarships for which you are eligible and applying.
- Detail your activities and time spent on each, achievements and honors in the spaces provided.
- Only list activities, achievements and honors from the previous 4 years.
- Keep descriptions brief and to the point.
- Limit essay(s) length to one page or less.
- Do not staple materials together.
- Faxed copies are not accepted.
- Complete applications must be received in the USPC National Office by March 31<sup>st</sup> (not postmarked). Mail to: USPC Scholarships, 4041 Iron Works Pkwy, Lexington, KY 40511.
- Submit:
  1. application and required essay
  2. two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from your DC or RS
  3. a current transcript
  4. a letter (may be a copy) from the college/institution verifying current enrollment or acceptance(s)
  5. only one application even if applying for more than one scholarship
- Complete the activity section and submit the additional essay for the Anson Taylor Scholarship *only if* applying for that scholarship.
