**I. PHILOSOPHY:**

In order to develop and encourage among youth throughout the United States a knowledge of horsemanship, including the care of horses, to encourage fair and friendly competition, to develop understanding and sympathy for the horse by its rider, and by these and other means to help develop in members strength of character, confidence and leadership skills, the Board of Governors recognizes the necessity to develop a mission statement.

**II. POLICY STATEMENT:**

The policy of the Board of Governors is that the Mission Statement of The United States Pony Clubs, Inc. shall be formed in partnership with members, parents, officers and Board, and shall be ratified by the Board of Governors.

**IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:**

- B. Committee members, chairs, and the appropriate Vice Presidents shall have the responsibility for this policy at the national level.
- C. The Board of Governors and the President shall have oversight of this policy.
