I. PHILOSOPHY:

In order to develop well-rounded equestrians, the United States Pony Clubs, Inc. will provide a broad based education needed to enjoy horses in a safe, able and competent manner.

II. POLICY STATEMENT:

The policy of the Board of Governors is that the core activities of The United States Pony Clubs, Inc. are based on the instruction of horse management and the instruction in any equestrian discipline supported by the organization.


III. AMPLIFYING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES:

- A. Horse Management is a required Core Activity.
- B. Participation in other Core Activities is encouraged as time, skill and opportunity permit.
- C. The Regional Supervisor shall monitor the clubs and centers in the Region for compliance with this policy.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:

- A. The DC, CA, and RS shall have the responsibility for this policy at the local and regional levels.
- B. Committee members, chairs, and the appropriate Vice Presidents shall have the responsibility for this policy at the national level.
- C. The Board of Governors and the President shall have oversight of this policy.
