

## **ATTACHMENT B TO POLICY 0910**

### **BITTING**

In order to enable the Pony Club member to ride safely and to effect control without causing pain or injury to the horse, the Board of Governors recognizes the need for specific biting requirements for instructional activities and competitions in Pony Club.

- A. Biting at local, regional and national instructional activities, testings and interclub competitive rallies:  
The Regional Supervisor (RS), District Commissioner (DC), Center Administrator (CA), Chief Horse Management Judge (CHMJ), Examiner or Chief Instructor shall determine whether or not a bit is suitable for an instructional activity, interclub competitive rally, or testing.
  
- B. Biting at Regional and higher rallies:  
Biting for each discipline will conform to the rules established by the specific USPC competitions committee as specified in the current rulebook.
