I. POLICY STATEMENT AND PHILOSOPHY

A. The United States Pony Clubs, Inc. is fully committed to safeguarding the welfare and the safety of our Members, Leaders, and Volunteers. USPC requires background checks and the satisfactory completion of USPC designated educational training modules of individuals as specified in the procedures. These must be completed prior to these individuals assuming positions as Officers, Leaders, or Educators of members, or beginning specified membership terms. Background checks must be repeated periodically and training modules when revisions are made to them.

1. USPC also requires compliance with any and all applicable local, state, and/or Federal laws concerning background checks, screenings and/or clearance, and shall enforce the same to the extent required by such laws.
2. USPC shall respond immediately to any allegations of misconduct or abuse.

B. The required trainings include Member Protection; Concussion, and Heat Illness.


C. USPC Leaders or Volunteers not in compliance shall not be permitted to serve in any capacity having the aforementioned requirements.

II. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:

- A. The National Office shall have responsibility for monitoring compliance of this policy.
- B. The Vice President of Activities, the Vice President of Instruction, the Vice President of Regional Administration, the Chair of the Safety Committee and the President shall have oversight of this policy.
