***A. The National Youth Congress/Academy of Achievement (NYC/AofA)
Committee:***

- Organizes and administers the 2 ½ day program each year.
- Sets all standards and procedures for selection of youth delegates and alumni honorees.
- Notifies all clubs and riding centers early in the year of the standards and procedures for selecting youth delegates to the Youth Congress.
- Solicits nationally for nominations of outstanding alumni for induction into the Academy.
- Selects alumni honorees.
- Communicates with youth delegates and alumni honorees as needed.
- Provides an extensive program of workshops, discussions and other activities intended to help youth delegates to understand themselves better and to prepare for the opportunities and challenges in life after Pony Club.
- Incorporates alumni honorees into the program wherever possible.
- Plans and implements appropriate awards and activities to honor the alumni honorees.
- Provides opportunities for youth delegates to share ideas with USPC Leaders.
- Notifies the Annual Meeting of the presence of youth delegates and alumni honorees.
- Provides opportunities and systems for evaluation and improvement of the program.
