SUBJECT: NATIONAL ACTIVITY COMMITTEES - RULE CHANGES

POLICY NO: 6002

I. PHILOSOPHY:

In order to provide for an orderly, progressive, and logical change in Pony Club activities rules, the Board of Governors believes that oversight and review are important features of such change.

II. POLICY STATEMENT:

The policy of the Board of Governors is that activity rule changes shall be presented to the Program Administration Council (PAC) for adoption in a careful, timely manner.

III. AMPLIFYING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES:

- A. Changes in rules must be submitted by committees to the Vice President of Activities in accordance with procedures approved by PAC.
- B. The Vice President of Activities will review rule changes and report progress to PAC.
- C. Rulebooks must be finalized and printed in accordance with procedures and timelines, as determined by PAC.
- D. Extraordinary rule changes may be enacted and become effective immediately as necessary.

IV. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:

The Vice President of Activities shall have oversight of this policy.
