**I. PHILOSOPHY:**

In order to integrate with the equestrian community and to enhance USPC's programs, the Board of Governors endorses membership in or liaisons with other horse/equestrian groups.

**II. POLICY STATEMENT:**

The policy of the Board of Governors is that The United States Pony Clubs, Inc. may hold membership in and/or appoint representatives to other horse/equestrian groups.


**III. AMPLIFYING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES:**
