

## **POLICY 1000P MEMBERSHIP PROCEDURES CORPORATE AND LIFE MEMBERS**

In order to ensure that USPC policy, rules, and regulations are created and/or approved by members of USPC of and for the benefit of USPC, Corporate or Life Membership in USPC is necessary for those in policy-making positions and any others as listed in these procedures.

National Youth Board members serving on the Board of Governors and/or on a National Committee (Activities, Instruction, Regional Administration and/or a Board Committee) are granted a Corporate Membership during the duration of their term.

The following positions require current Corporate Membership/Life Membership:

1. District Commissioners (DCs) and Joint-District Commissioners.
2. Riding Center Program Administrators (CAs) and Assistant Riding Center Program Administrators.
3. Regional Supervisors (RSs) and Vice-Regional Supervisors.
4. Officers and members of the Board of Governors.
5. Members of the Advisory Committee of the Board of Governors.
6. Members of the Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors.
7. Chairpersons and members of the National Activities, Instruction, and Regional Administration Committees.
8. National Examiners (NEs).
9. Chief Horse Management Judges (CHMJs).
10. Regional Instruction Coordinators (RICs).
11. Horse Management Organizers (HMOs).
